



## 2018-2019 Tuition and Fees Schedule

### Application Fee

\$75 per new student (**Non-refundable**). The fee must be submitted with the Application for Admission form.

**The Enrollment fee is non-refundable.** For new students, the enrollment fee is due within 2 weeks of acceptance. A student may not start school until the enrollment fee has been paid.

### Tuition Monthly Payment Plan

Tuition payments are made through our online tuition management system. A late fee of \$40 will be assessed for late monthly payments. Faithful commitment to your tuition payment plan will ensure your student's continual enrollment at CCS.

### Sports Participation Fee

One interscholastic sport fee per sixth through twelfth grade student is included in the enrollment fee. There is a \$100 fee for each additional sport.

### After School Study Hall

After school supervision is provided from 3:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m. billed at \$5.00 per hour (hourly rate is assessed for any portion of the hour). Additional Pre-Kindergarten and VPK information is listed on a separate sheet.

### Parent Pledge

The Parent Pledge is a voluntary tax-deductible gift made to the school to help offset educational costs. Because it is a faith pledge, each family is asked to consider this amount first prayerfully. Some can make a more significant pledge than others, but it is necessary to receive approximately \$500 per family. Pledge gifts can be given on a one time or recurring basis through the CCS website.
